## Do you have a Google Account?

- Any account used on Gmail, Google Docs, YouTube, etc. will work.
- **If you already have a Google Account skip to the 2nd to last page ( page 10).**
- If you don't have a Google account, you can create one as described on the following pages.
- **For students under 13 or those who do not want a full Google account skip to page 8.**

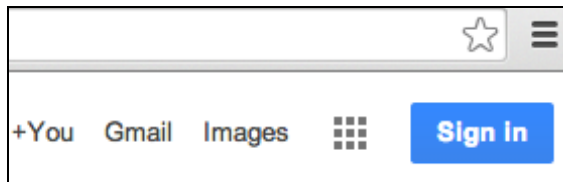
# Create a Full Account

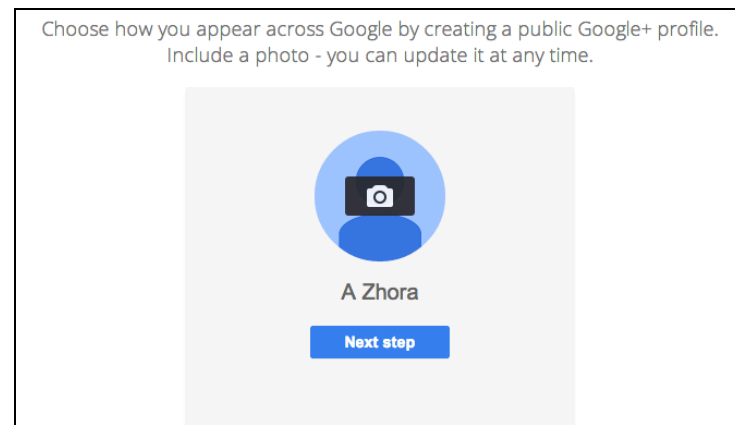
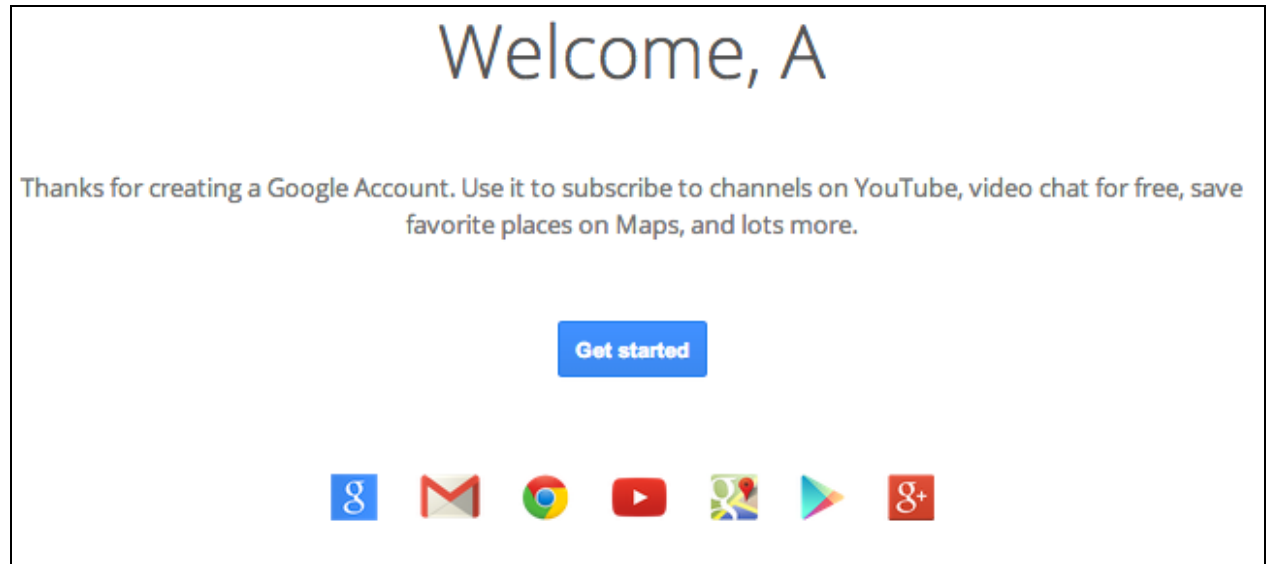

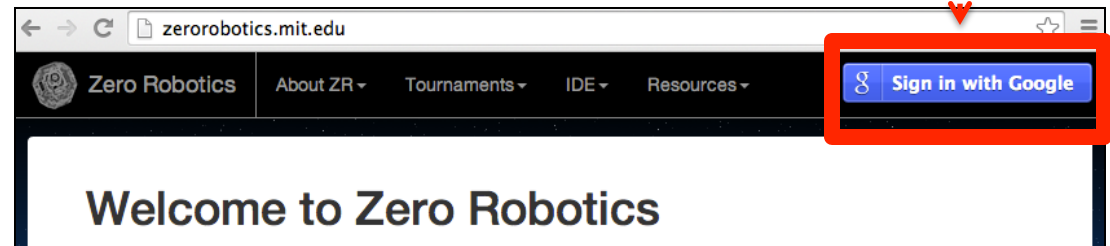

## Log In on the Zero Robotics Website



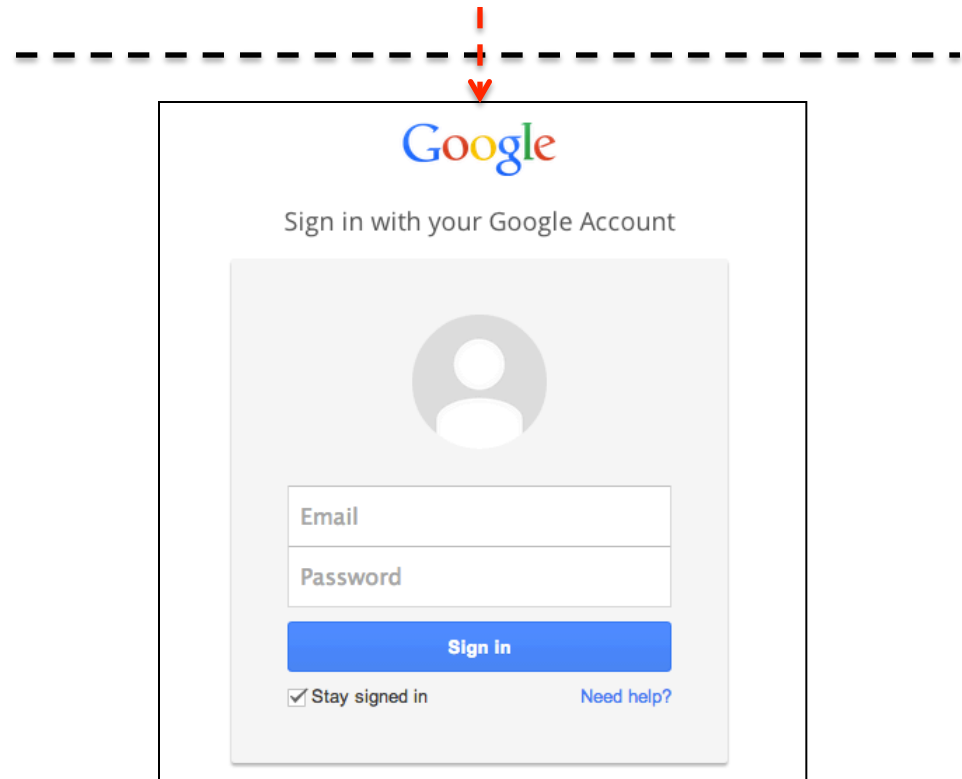
12. Go to the Zero Robotics website:
